Realizing that people were missing and hungry for the fellowship normally shared at Torch, the organizer arranged for a Zoom social gathering. It enabled the members to connect on a more personal level, to have some conversation, and to interact with friends . . . which brings me to my **INVITATION** to all of you.

At our October board meeting I recommended that we go ahead with a Torch gathering on the first Thursday in December, that is, December 3, at 7 p.m. This gathering will not have a presentation, but it will be organized in such a way that participants will have lots of opportunity to meet and speak with old friends and simply enjoy an hour of sociability with no real agenda. We will distribute an email message with the Zoom link a few days prior to the social gathering.

The way it will work is that after a brief time to log on and get situated, participants will be put in small groups for about 10 minutes at a time, rotating three times over the course of the hour. We finally will come back together as a whole to conclude.

We have some experts who know how to manage such a thing remotely, so all you would have to do is log on as you normally would and "leave the driving to us." For those who might be intimidated or turned off by having to exist in a disembodied world, I completely understand, but I hope you will relent and give it a try. If you need assistance, we can provide that. Just let me know.
